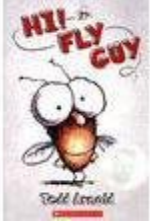


First grade reading list

by Leo Lionni

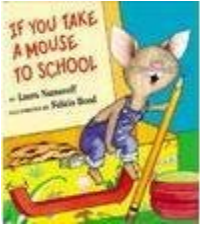
Share this tribute to friendship and self-identity with your own child, who simultaneously seeks comfort and independence.
